## Removal

## NOTE:

The right hand sensor has a black colored lever and the left hand sensor has a white colored lever.

WARNING: Do not work on or under a vehicle supported only by a jack. Always support the vehicle on safety stands.

Raise and support the vehicle.

Remove the wheel and tire.



CAUTION: Do not use excessive force to disconnect the height sensor link.

Remove the suspension height sensor.

- Disconnect the height sensor link arm.
  - Disconnect the electrical connector.
- Remove the 2 Torx screws.



## Installation

1.

To install, reverse the removal procedure.

Tighten the screws to 2.2 Nm (1.5 lb.ft).

CAUTION: Height suspension calibration, using T4, must always be carried out if the suspension height sensor fixings are removed.

Use T4 to re-calibrate the suspension system.
