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## Receiver Drier (82.17.03)

## Removal

## NOTE:

The receiver drier need only be changed under the following circumstances: There is dirt in the refrigerant circuit ( eg. compressor seizure ). The system is leaking and refrigerant has been lost to atmosphere. Refrigerant circuit has been open more than 24 hours due to repair.

WARNING: Do not work on or under a vehicle supported only by a jack. Always support the vehicle on safety stands.

Raise and support the vehicle.

- 2. Remove the condenser core. For additional information, refer to Condenser Core (82.15.07) (Section 412-03)
- 3. Remove the receiver drier support bracket clamp.
  - Loosen the screw.

CAUTION: Immediately cap all refrigerant lines to prevent ingress of dirt and moisture.

Remove the receiver drier.

- Remove the bolt.
- Remove the clamp.
- Remove and discard the 2 O-ring seals.



## Installation

- 1. Install the receiver drier.
  - Clean the component mating faces.
  - Install new O-ring seals.
  - Install the clamp.
  - Tighten the bolt to 10 Nm (7 lb.ft).

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2. Install the condenser core. For additional information, refer to <u>Condenser Core (82.15.07)</u> (Section 412-03)

3. Connect the battery ground cable.
