
Shock Absorber and Spring Assembly (60.30.25/99)

Removal


WARNING: Do not work on or under a vehicle supported only by a jack. Always support the vehicle on safety stands.


Raise and support the vehicle.

- 2 . Remove the fender splash shield. For additional information, refer to <u>Fender Splash Shield</u> (76.10.48) (Section 501-02)
- 3. Disconnect the shock absorber and spring assembly from the lower arm.
 - Remove the nut and bolt.




4 . Release the heat shield for access to the shock absorber and spring assembly upper mounting inner nut.





- 5. Remove the shock absorber and spring assembly.
 - Remove the three retaining bolts.



Installation

- 1. Install the shock absorber and spring assembly.
 - Make sure the spring and shock absorber assembly top mounting to body mating faces are clean.
 - Fit the nuts and tighten to 63 Nm (46 lb.ft).
- 2. Secure the heat shield.
 - Install the three retaining bolts and tighten to 10 Nm (7 lb.ft).
- 3. Connect the shock absorber and spring assembly to the lower arm.
 - Tighten the nut and bolt to 300 Nm (221 lb.ft).
- 4. Install the fender splash shield. For additional information, refer to Fender Splash Shield (76.10.48) (Section 501-02)
